WE PERFORM FREE HOME REPAIRS FOR VULNERABLE HOMEOWNERS

We send out teams of adult and teenage volunteers who give freely of their time and energy to perform free home repairs for homeowners.

WHAT KIND OF REPAIRS CAN THE VOLUNTEERS DO?

Our work teams are not professional contractors. Most team members are relatively inexperienced adults and teenagers. Nevertheless, we aim to do good quality work that is a service to you. Our teams do most home repair projects, including painting, dry walling, carpentry, and some masonry, roofing, and plumbing.

WHO SUPERVISES THE WORK?

Teams are directly supervised by the adult leaders who come with the teams. Sometimes the adults are pastors or teachers; sometimes they are volunteers who enjoy helping people learn to serve and grow in their faith. Our staff members travel from worksite to worksite to deliver supplies, to encourage the team, to help build bridges of friendship among the team members and you, and to offer technical assistance to the teams.

DO THE VOLUNTEERS GET PAID?

No, they don't. All the students and adult leaders volunteer their time and efforts.

WHO CAN APPLY?

To apply for work to be done on your house, you must meet all three of the following qualifications:

- 1) You must own your home and live in it.
- 2) You must live in the City of Colorado Springs or in a neighboring community.
- 3) You must document that your household's income was at or below 150 percent of the Federal Poverty Guidelines for the previous 12 months.

Among the applicants who meet these requirements, we place a priority on candidates who exhibit poor health, due to disability or illness, and/or are age 60 and older. We are not able to help everyone who applies. Once we receive your application, we will confirm that we have received it.
